Application and Relevance

Participants will have the skills and knowledge to perform basic life support procedures and manage other potential serious first aid conditions. This workshop has been designed as an awareness workshop for parent, grandparents or relatives who care for young children.

Prerequisites

Duration

2 hours classroom training.

Workshop Content

This workshop provides the skills and knowledge to be able to handle cardiac emergency situations.

It includes:

- Perform CPR to child and infant.
- Manage an unconscious casualty
- Manage a choking child or infant
- Manage a febrile convulsion
- Manage a casualty with external bleeding
- Poisoning
- Manage a casualty with anaphylaxis including epipen administration
- Bites and stings
- Burns and scalds
- Manage a child with Asthma
- First Aid Kits and their contents
